THE FAQS

Q: Is the Courthouse Square ADA accessible?

A: As a historic site there will be parts of our property that will not be fully accessible to all visitors. We encourage teachers to reach out to us to see how we can make history fun for all students.

Q: Are there places to eat lunch?

A: Yes! You can "picnic" on the grounds, on the Jail Plaza, and inside the courtroom. We just ask that students throw away all their trash to reduce the attraction of bugs. Outdoor locations are weather dependent.

Q: Do you have a gift shop?

A: Yes, and it will be open to your students. We carry a wide variety of items so that every child has a chance to shop. Shoppers are charged sales tax and should budget accordingly.

Q: Do you still host Pioneer Day?

A: We no longer host Pioneer Day and instead have made available a host of activities you can add to your tour or in-class experience!


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

Option A: Tour Only

- Grades: K-12
- Schedule Time: 1.5 2 hours
- Location: On-site
- Cost: \$5.00 per person

The tour of the grounds will last approximately 30 - 40 minutes with remaining time open for free exploration by students.

Option B: Tour & Activity

- Grades: K-12
- Schedule Time: 2 2.5 hours
- Location: On-site
- Cost: \$8.00 per person

The tour of the grounds will last approximately 30 - 40 minutes with a small break afterwards. The activity portion will last about 45 minutes.
