Q: Is the Courthouse Square ADA accessible?

A: As a historic site, there will be parts of our property that will not be fully accessible to all visitors. We encourage coordinators to reach out to see how we can make history fun for all attendees.

Q: Are there places to eat?

A: Yes! You can opt to bring/cater food on-site or you can make reservations at restaurants in town. Your group size may preclude you from some locations.

CHOOSE YOUR ADVENTURE!

Option A: Museum Tour Only

- Schedule Time: 1.5 - 2 hours
- Cost: \$7.00 per person

The tour of the grounds will last approximately 30 - 40 minutes with remaining time open for free exploration by guests.

Option B: Museum Tour & Talk

- Schedule Time: 2 - 2.5 hours
- Cost: \$8.00 per person

The tour of the grounds will last approximately 30 - 40 minutes with a small break afterwards. The lecture portion will last about 45 minutes with Q&A time afterwards.

Option C: Off-site Lecture

- Schedule Time: 1.5 hours
- Cost: \$75.00

Expert staff from the BCHA will come to your location to present one of the eight lectures listed to the right.

Option D: Get to know us!

- Schedule Time: 30 minutes
- Cost: Free
